

NOAC requirements

All youth and adults attending NOAC will be required to:

- Provide a Class 3 medical. A Class 3 is a high-adventure medical less than one year old for all delegates.
- Wear a complete and full uniform. There will be times where a class B uniform is acceptable, but the majority of the time the class A is worn.
- Expectations
We have to count on you to be trusted on your own.
Long walks and physical activities are the norm.
You must be able to navigate a large college campus, and able to find your way back in the dark after shows and activities.
We expect all delegates to be responsible enough to meet all sign-up, ordering, medical and other deadlines without being prodded or reminded.
We expect exemplary behavior of all delegates. You represent our Lodge and Council. Behavior problems will be sent home at the expense of the parents.

Adult Selection Criterion

The NOAC limits the number of adults attending the event to a ratio of two youth for every adult. Each adult delegate will be responsible for leadership functions and possibly transportation.

Anpetu-We adult delegates will be selected on the following basis:

- A. Lodge advisers, chapter advisers, and the NOAC adult adviser will be offered first delegate spots.
- B. Order of the Arrow members whose sons are attending as youth will be offered next.
- C. Adult Arrowmen who have not before attended a NOAC will next be selected.
- D. Should any of the levels above exceed our quota of adults, delegates will be chosen by lottery.
- E. All other adult arrowmen will be chosen by lottery for remaining spots.
